

Regulation No. 2/2021 of 20 April, 2021

Director of the Lower Vistula Landscape Park in Świecie

regarding: the introduction of *Visitor Regulations for the Chrystkowo Teaching Museum*

§ 1

I hereby establish the *Visitor Regulations for the Chrystkowo Teaching Museum* at the Teaching Museum of the Lower Vistula Landscape Park, constituting the appendix to this regulation.

§ 2

The Rules introduced by Regulation No. 4/2015 of July 14, 2015 shall cease to have effect.

§ 3

The regulation shall enter into force on the day of signing.

Visitor Regulations for the Chrystkowo Teaching Museum of the Lower Vistula Landscape Park

1. The buildings of the ZPKnDW Teaching Museum in Chrystkowo may be visited during opening hours.
2. During the tourist season (i.e. 1 May to 31 September), the ZPKnDW Teaching Museum in Chrystkowo is open all Fridays and weekends and most public holidays during the following hours.

Outside the tourist season (i.e. 1 Oct – 30 Apr) the Museum is open by prior arrangement by telephone, on: **602-426-427, 602-427-428** on working days from 10.00-14.00

3. Two excursion groups may visit the Teaching Museum at any one time.

4. Only one excursion group may be in the buildings of the Teaching Museum Center at any one time. Group sizes may not exceed restrictions on attendance in confined spaces in force at the time.
5. Priority in visits will be given to groups booked by prior arrangement.
6. During the visit, visitor group leaders remain responsible for the members of their groups.
7. The use of cameras and video cameras is allowed only outside buildings.
8. Photographing and filming of the Teaching Museum for commercial purposes is permitted only with written consent of the Directorate of the Lower Vistula Landscape Park.
9. During a storm, visitors are required to leave the Teaching Museum.
10. Smoking of tobacco and e-cigarettes on the premises of the Teaching Museum is allowed only in designated places.
11. In the event that first aid must be provided, please contact the Teaching Museum staff.
12. The following are strictly forbidden on the premises of the Teaching Museum:
 - entry to motor vehicles,
 - damage to greenery and lighting of fires
 - scaring, chasing or feeding of livestock
 - bringing dogs (or other animals) unleashed
 - bicycling or horse riding
